**Galerie ART CRU Berlin** and **Alexandra von Gersdorff** published the first detailed monograph of **Achim Maaz** (1955-2014, Bonn) to honor his life's work. The 240-page volume with approximately 190 illustrations is published by **Favoritenpresse** and is available for immediate purchase.

In addition to contributions from the artist's personal companions, the catalog features an extensive essay by **Klaus Mecherlein**, Director of Atelier Augustinum & Euward Archive. It is the most detailed art historical study of Achim Maaz's work to date. The author is a co-founder of the Euward, the world's most prestigious art award for painting and graphic art in the context of mental disability, for which the artist has already been nominated twice and presented in this context at the Haus der Kunst in Munich.

#### The artist:

Achim Maaz, is an outstanding artist in the realm of Outsider Art. His artwork tells the extraordinary story of a gifted drawer who, despite facing mental disabilities and a limited ability to communicate, dedicated his entire life to expressing himself artistically within the confines of psychiatric institutions. Achim Maaz's work is characterized by intricate and elaborate ballpoint pen hatchings, pencil drawings, and occasionally adorned with virtuoso oil pastel paintings. Within the art world, his creations stand alone, unmatched in their uniqueness. The large-scale format of Maaz's pieces is accentuated by the prominent border formed by the edge of the drawing paper. The figures he portrays often possess pressed, neckless heads, as if they were intricately pressed into the pictorial space, enclosed within their own physicality. Through his original and intimate paintings, Maaz subtly and intensely conveys the experiences of confinement and an underlying urge to break free. These themes dominate the atmosphere of his artwork, evoking a sense of introspection and emotional resonance.

During his lifetime, the artist was exhibited several times in the Rhineland, as well as in the Buchheim Museum, Bernried, as part of his Euward nomination, in addition to the aforementioned Haus der Kunst. The Berlin public still remembers Achim Maaz through the exhibition " Geheimnis und Faktum" ("Secret and Fact") curated by Christoph Tannert, Artistic Director Künstlerhaus Bethanien, in 2019.

#### The publishers:

As a nonprofit Galerie ART CRU Berlin oversees the estate of the artist, who died unexpectedly in 2014, just two weeks before a long-planned exhibition opening at the gallery, which had been organized in collaboration with the Kunsthistorisches Institut Bonn. Since then, the gallery has been committed to preserving the estate and presenting the works to the public. Alexandra von Gersdorff

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is an artist, occupational therapist and founder of PS-Art e.V. Berlin. She managed the Galerie ART CRU Berlin for 13 years and has been committed to the artist and his work for 10 years now.

#### Acknowledgements:

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**Galerie ART CRU Berlin** is Berlin's only gallery for so-called Outsider Art since 2008. The term (introduced in 1945 by painter Jean Dubuffet as "Art Brut") refers to art by people with psychiatric disorders or mental disabilities. The gallery team is convinced that the particular perceptions these artists have allow them to create art of high authenticity. The exhibitions present works by "outsiders" as an important position in contemporary art. The aim is to stimulate an active discourse with the established art world. Located in the Kunsthof on Oranienburger Straße, the gallery positions works by outsider artists in the middle of the Berlin art scene.

Galerie ART CRU Berlin is backed by the association PS-Art e.V. Berlin, a network of various psychosocial institutions. In 2022, the gallery was awarded the Ulrike-Fritze-Lindenthal Prize for its inclusive work, the destignatization award of the German Association for Psychiatry, Psychotherapy and Psychosomatics (DGPPN).



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Untitled, undated, ballpoint pen on paper with torn off adhesive particles, 89x70



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




Untitled, undated, oil pastels on newspaper, 52,5x72
